

Panoramic roof for this model consists of sliding roof switch, sliding roof glass, power sunshade, sliding roof motor, sunshade motor, sliding roof module and sliding roof drain hoses.

Basic Function Introduction

Auto Mode

Automatic glass level opening, automatic glass level closing, automatic glass tilt opening, automatic glass tilt closing, automatic sunshade level opening, automatic sunshade level closing.

Inching (Manual) Mode

Glass level inching opening, glass level inching closing, sunshade level inching opening, sunshade level inching closing.

Jam Protection Reversal Distance

- 1. If jam protection occurs in sliding roof between 4 and 200 mm, glass/sunshade will return to the position at 250 mm. For position outside of 200 mm, glass/sunshade may return by 50 mm, but it cannot beyond the full open position.
- 2. Tilt direction: reverse to tilt height.

Logical Function Introduction

Manual Mode for Glass

Under manual mode, press glass Open/Close button, to manually open/close the glass. When releasing the sliding roof switch after glass reaches to proper position, glass will stay at the current position.

When glass is at any position between fully closed and comfort position, glass moves to opening direction and stops at comfort position finally after pressing the Open button. If continues to open, release the button and press it again.

Manual Mode for Sunshade

Under manual mode, press sunshade Open/Close button, to manually open/close the sunshade. When releasing the sunshade switch after sunshade reaches to proper position, sunshade will stay at the current position.

When sunshade is at any position between fully closed and mid position, sunshade moves to opening direction and stops at mid position finally after pressing the Open button. If continues to open, release the button and press it again.

When sunshade is at any position between fully open and mid position, sunshade moves to closing direction and stops at mid position finally after pressing the Close button. If continues to close, release the button and press it again.

Auto Mode for Glass

Under auto mode, press glass Open/Close button, to automatically open/close the glass;

If glass is at close position, glass will tilt to maximum angle automatically when inching the glass Close button.

If glass is at maximum tilt angle, glass will close automatically when pressing the glass Open button.

If glass is at close position, glass will open to comfort position automatically when pressing the glass Open button, and it will run to fully open position after pressing the Open button again.

If glass is at open position, glass will close automatically when pressing the glass Close button.

Auto Mode for Sunshade

Under auto mode, press sunshade Open/Close button, to automatically open/close the sunshade;

If sunshade is at fully closed position, sunshade will run to mid position automatically when pressing the sunshade Open button, and it will run to fully open position after pressing the the sunshade Open button again.

If sunshade is at fully open position, sunshade will run to mid position automatically when pressing the sunshade Close button, and it will run to fully closed position after pressing the the sunshade Close button again.



Sliding Roof Learning

Sliding roof or sunshade initial position losing

Definition: Sliding roof or sunshade cannot be opened, closed normally or closed to a normal position, and initial movement for sliding roof or sunshade cannot be performed. When there is such problem in sliding roof or sunshade, movement process for sliding roof or sunshade will be disordered, that is, sliding roof or sunshade loses the initial position.

Problem Symptom

- 1. Sliding roof cannot be closed and opened completely or tilted. Shuddering may occur during the process from tilt to close.
- 2. When opening or closing sliding roof or sunshade, it cannot reach to initial set position.
- 3. A function that pressing the button once to automatically open and close sliding roof or sunshade cannot be performed.
- 4. Sliding roof or sunshade operation cannot be controlled by sliding roof module.

Solution Method

For specific details, perform repairs according to following steps. Make sure that power supply shall not be shut off during operation; and confirm that no hard objects (various obstacles) that block running of sliding mechanism are in sliding roof rail and sunshade rail.

Glass reinitialization:

- 1. Perform ON -> OFF -> ON operations for IGN within 5 seconds;
- Within 3 seconds after first operation, press and hold Close button (manual close and automatic close mode are available), then glass will reach the tilt position and a "click" sound is heard;
- 3. If the Close button is pressed and held all along after stuck, glass will perform operations below in order: tilt close -> full open -> full close; sunshade stops running after the process is finished, then release the button:
- 4. Initialization is finished.

Sunshade reinitialization:

- 1. Perform ON -> OFF -> ON operations for IGN within 5 seconds;
- 2. Within 3 seconds after first operation, press and hold Close button (manual close and automatic close mode are available), then sunshade will reach the fully closed position and a "click" sound is heard;
- 3. If the Close button is pressed and held all along after stuck, sunshade will perform operations below in order: full open -> full close; sliding roof stops running after the process is finished, then release the button;
- 4. Initialization is finished.

CAUTION

After replacing sliding roof motor, sunshade motor, sliding roof module, sliding roof assembly or if entire
vehicle power is cut off, perform sliding roof and sunshade initialization procedures.
